## **Palm-Muting**

Another quite easy technique which is very useful especially when you play rhythm guitar or chords during a song. Palm muting is used to mute the strings while you play. Depending on how much you damp the strings you can get a really dark and heavy sound, or just use it to prevent unwanted noises from the strings. Especially on the electric guitar this technique sounds very good!

For palm muting (short p.m.) lay the edge of your palm lightly near the bridge on the strings of your guitar. But beware, you don't want to kill the notes you play!

Play the following riffs while you're muting the strings.
